

WALKING THE TALK: LET'S HELP HASEENA



The story of Haseena Hussain's acid attack, published in *Marie Claire* December 2006, was a wake-up call for us. Overwhelming feedback flooded our office. We decided to walk our talk and open a relief fund for the 12 surgeries she needs to be able to live independently. "I want to stand on my own feet; I want to work; I want to live," says Haseena. She is disfigured, visionless, unemployed and has no life outside her house. She lives with hope. We can give her a life. Let's help her.

The anguish in Haseena Hussain's voice is almost too painful to bear. "I thought it was over, but the fear and the waiting has started again." Last year, when the Karnataka High Court sentenced her attacker, Joseph Rodriguez, to life imprisonment, Haseena and her parents thought justice - of some sort - had been served. Cruelly enough, the legal system that took seven years to punish Rodriguez has let him file an appeal - this time in the Supreme Court.

Haseena was 20 when Rodriguez, her former employer, drenched her in

sulphuric acid for rejecting his advances. Today, she has lost her sight and has undergone 27 plastic surgeries. More remain, but there is no money left. She cannot move out of her home in Bangalore due to her disfigurement. The High Court had directed Rodriguez to pay her Rs 5 lac; he paid only Rs 3 lac - which the court put in a fixed deposit for her. He will probably not pay the rest.

When *Marie Claire* carried Haseena's story last December, the response was overwhelming. Readers from across India expressed their concern, even sent money for her surgeries. To

channelise these resources, *Marie Claire* and *Outlook* have set up a fund - 'Outlook Relief Fund A/C Haseena Hussain'. To kick-start this effort, every *Marie Claire* staffer will donate a day's salary. We will run the fund for six months; the money collected will be given to Haseena to enable further surgeries. Donations above Rs 2,000 will receive a special mention in *Marie Claire*.

Remarkably, Haseena has not lost hope; she wants to work. Her case will take long to be settled but she is steadfast. "The truth will win," she says. "That is all I can dare to believe."
